

BE FIRST

Nothing But The Truth For The Proof

The Origins Foundation is positioning itself as the global leader in unbiased truth-telling around sustainable use issues. From duck hunting in New Zealand, to predator management in the United Kingdom, to Black Bears in the United States. If you want to know the truth, conveyed in an honest, authentic, unbiased manner, we are the voice globally that hunters, the general public, and news outlets are turning to.

BE IMPACTFUL

In 5 years what has The Origins Foundation actually done? What can you point to that shows the success and proof of your mission and work. A lot of non-profits will claim EVERY victory under the sun as theirs even though they had very little to do with it. We don't do that. Each victory below was shaped by us.



Defending Elephant Hunting in Botswana

The very first current elephant hunting controversy was documented in April of 2022 coming out of Botswana. It was on the heels of the government lifting the ban on elephant hunting. We were contacted as soon as the news started spreading to help defend the practice and the activity of elephant hunting. Over a short period of time we produced a series of 3 unbiased podcasts that provided all viewpoints around the issue, the information within was then used and published in over 30 newspaper articles around the world about that specific hunt.



Defending California Black Bears

In one of the very first policy talking heads we engaged in, we publicly addressed SB14, a senate bill proposed by Sen. Wiener from San Francisco, that a Black Bear hunt needed to be shut down in California. With public pressure, that started with us, resulted in the creation of Howl for Wildlife, and the science that the California Department of Fish and Wildlife had on black bear populations, the bill was soundly defeated, and publicly the anti-hunting brigade was admonished about their lack of seeing the science of sustainable use of black bears.



Defending Cabaneros, Spain

Because of our reputation on addressing sustainable use issues, we were alerted to a governmental take over of private land, shutting down hunting and any culling of wildlife in Cabaneros national park (that encompassed private land). We engaged the private landowners to disseminate several pieces of content, including a high end documentary called Cabaneros. Cabaneros got the ear and eye of Spanish journalists, resulting in a dozen articles and news opinion editorials about the catastrophe unfolding in Cabaneros due to the hunting ban. The landowners petitioned the European Union and using our film and on the ground data won their petition, which has resulted in the Spanish government now paying the landowners to cull their deer and pigs.



Defending Alberta Mountain Lion Hunting, Canada

In February 2025, a public controversy erupted in Southern Alberta after activists accused hunters of knowingly killing a female mountain lion with kittens. Wild Origins Canada investigated and refuted these claims by engaging with the hunters and addressing misinformation about mountain lion hunting and houndsmen in addition to revealing the truth about mountain lion research. We challenged media misinformation and prompted a national news outlet to retract an inaccurate story about this event. The issue was resolved when Mark Hall, the Director, briefed Alberta's Premier and assured the government of the hunters' ethics and integrity.



Tahrageddon

The very first project that The Origins Foundation was asked to say something about was when Forest and Bird in New Zealand were asking the government through the DOC Minister, Eugenie Sage, to eradicate tahr and undertake a mass cull. Tahrageddon was tied to a draft operational plan to be released July 1st. We received the DOP on June 28th and proceeded to create a series of videos articulating the voice of the New Zealand hunting community. That content resulted in helping the NZ Tahr Foundation to raise over \$250k to sue the government and create a more management culling plan that fit with hunting and management of tahr.



We're thrilled to announce something truly historic – **The Panyame Cheetah Project**. This isn't just another wildlife effort – it's the largest single relocation of cheetahs ever, a game-changing move to save one of the world's most endangered cheetah populations.

The Need For Elephant Management

There are a lot of mistruths when it comes to elephants, with the majority of the narrative dominated by large non-profit organizations claiming that elephants need saving. This couldn't be further from the truth. Elephants no longer need saving, but rather managing. Our campaign changes this narrative by creating a suite of content that challenges the status quo and educates the general public about the truth around elephants: there are too many elephants in some places, they need management, and saving is no longer what's needed.
